REGULATORY FRAMEWORKS TO GUIDE THE WCA REMEDIATION ACTION PLAN

The pollution and contamination in the Wonderfonteinspruit Catchment Area has given rise to a complex set of socio-economic issues which require urgent interventions from the relevant regulatory authorities and associated parties.

“To date, a stringent regulatory framework has been developed by the relevant regulatory authorities and this will inform the basis of most action and decisions relating to the remediation of the Wonderfonteinspruit catchment area” states Mr Orion Phillips a Senior Manager at the NNR and the chairperson of the WCA Remediation National Steering Committee.
